



## The Impact Early Learning Centre (Educare - Grade R)

Our Pre-school groups range from Educare through to Grade R, enabling us to cater for 2 to 6 year olds. The classrooms are fully equipped with games and teaching materials, which enable our teachers to provide a stimulating and creative atmosphere, in which students are guided and encouraged, through a rich hands-on experience, to develop optimally.

## Foundation Phase (Grade 1 - 3)

Focus is placed on reading in this phase and utilises the following outstanding reading tools, namely:

- A specially developed alphabet sequence
- Songs for each (phonetic) sound
- Physical activities including dance and play-acting

Learners are mainly lock-stepped in this phase to ensure that they develop strong social and learning skills. Young students are nurtured by the foundation phase, Teachers, who aim to help each child to find and fully develop their strengths.

## Intersen Phase (Grade 4 - 7)

In this phase all six learning areas are covered from the core subjects of maths and languages to the sciences, life orientation and arts and culture. Of course, it's not all seriousness in this phase; learners also have the opportunity to take part in many new ventures which have included a drumming circle, school camps as well as a dress-up luncheon. At all times in this phase, the individual needs of the children are identified and catered for through continuous assessment and support from a skilled and professional team.

## High School (Grade 8 – 12)

At Impact Academy, we, in association with Hatfield Christian Online School, offer the NSC (IEB), which is Umalusi recognized. The NSC (IEB) is an internationally benchmarked qualification, equivalent to Cambridge AS Level. The IEB produces a consistent average pass rate of around 98%, with up to 80% of learners achieving a bachelor's pass. Our school is a proudly online-school, enabling students to access our curriculum with specialist teachers based across the country providing expert tuition online

Online learning requires dedication, and students are expected to maintain a high degree of accountability. Impact Academy strives to provide the controlled, motivated environment for students to meet the demands of the curriculum, while allowing for the social aspects required at this age. Being part of the Impact family means that, on top of an excellent academic program, students still have the routine of going to school, being in a classroom and benefiting from in-person assistance from trained staff, as well as collaboration with their peers. Supervision is provided by our trained staff members, to enable students to remain focused and meet academic goals, however, we also encourage our students to immerse themselves in our extra-curricular program, to develop the whole child.
